Sculptural Art Pieces at South Terminal Complex

A series of digital collage images united in a free standing sculpture created by Robert Sterling Scott for installation at South Terminal Complex.

These artworks are derived from historical references depicting the evolution of Central Florida. Robert collects these visual references and, using a proprietary digital collage system, combines them to evolve into a singular artwork.

This singular artwork comprised of multiple images are then combined into a singular form which will be explained and detailed on the following slides.

Sculptural Art Pieces at South Terminal Complex

These singular artworks will be presented to the public as a standalone sculptural unit. The selected artworks for this sculpture will be permanently printed on a metal substrate. There will be six images, three on each side of the sculpture. Each image will be modified into a circular disk and mounted on a power coated metal base and frame. The base will be 5'x5' and the sculpture will rise 12' above the base.

The idea is to create something new from a series of historical images of Orlando and Central Florida. The final selection of the six images to be used will be determined jointly by the Authority and the artist, Robert Sterling Scott

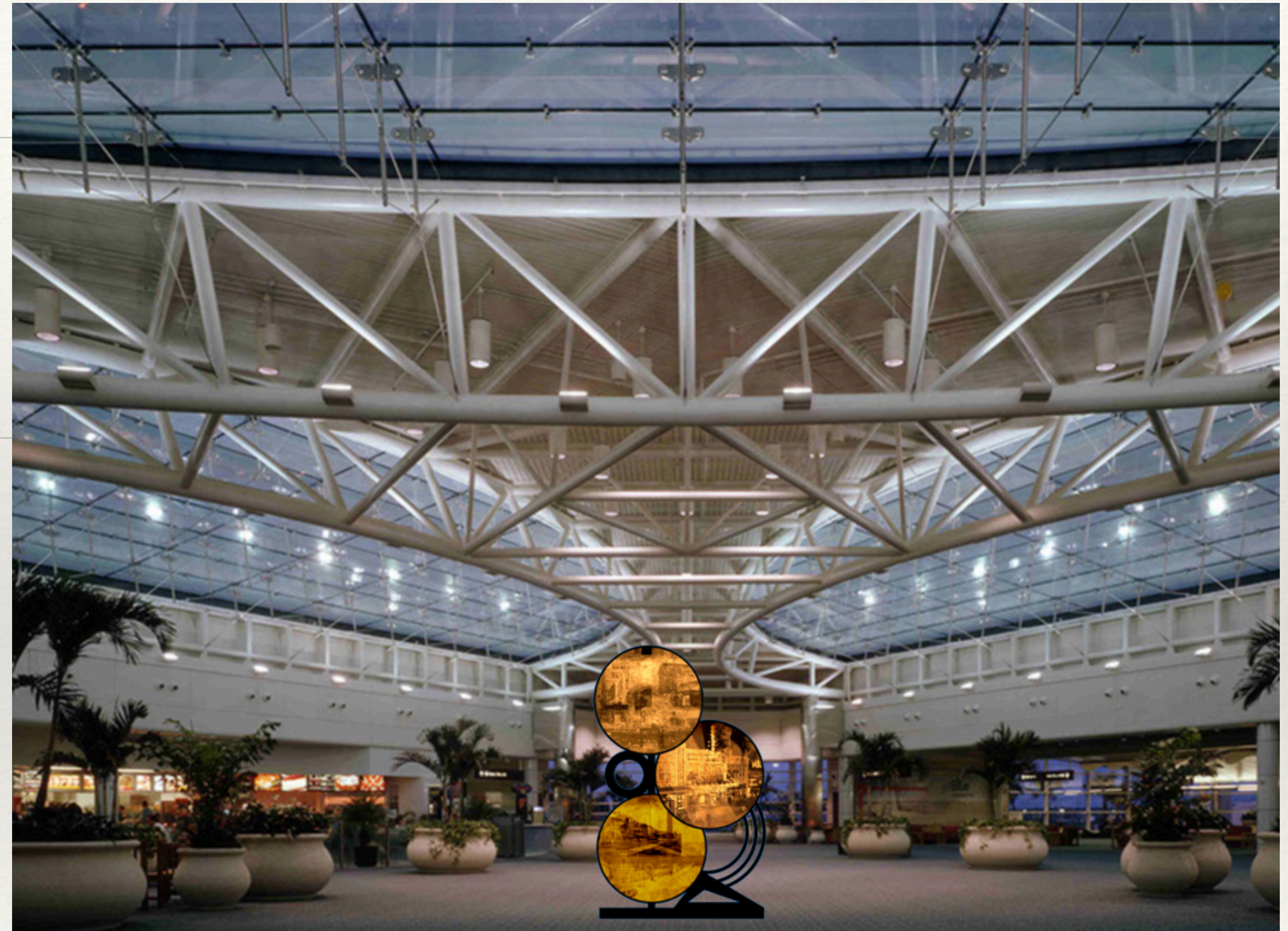

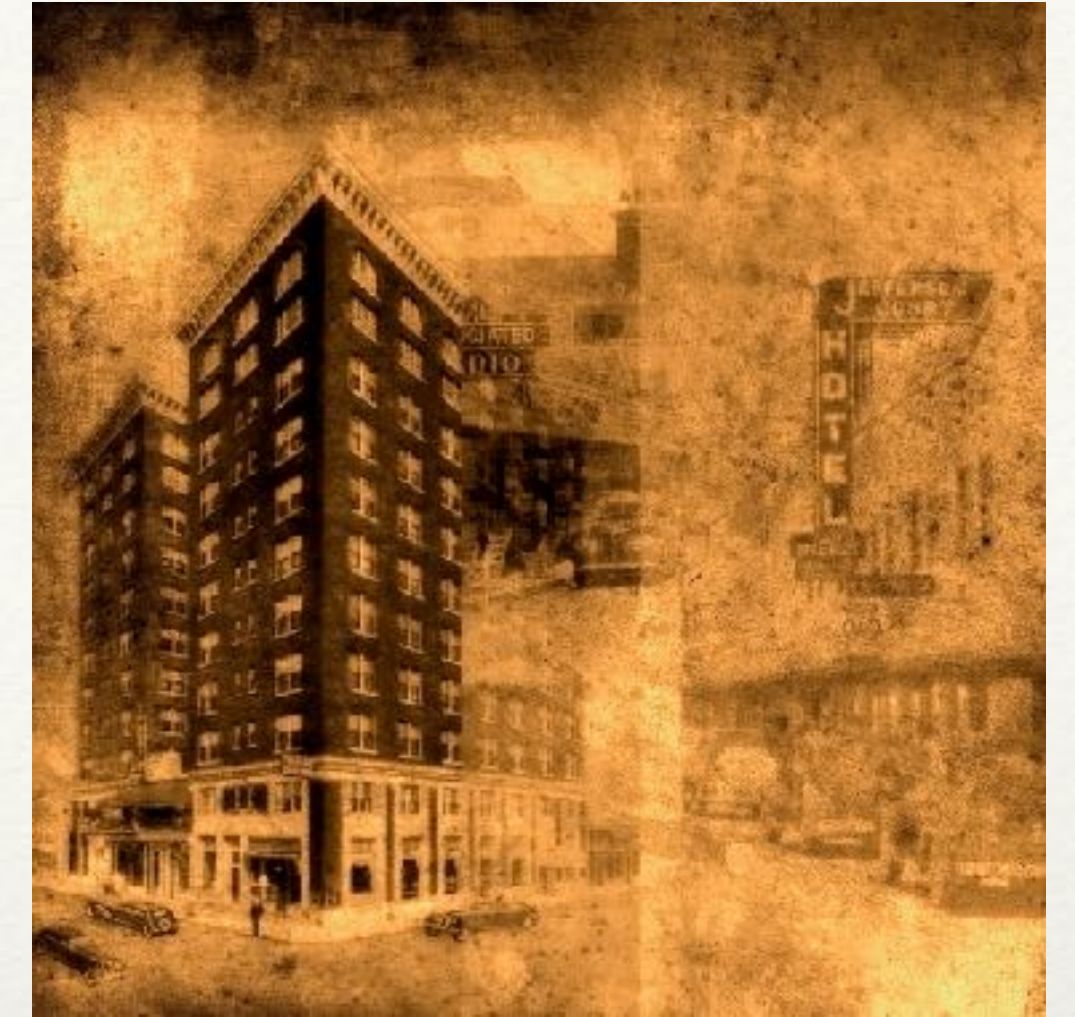

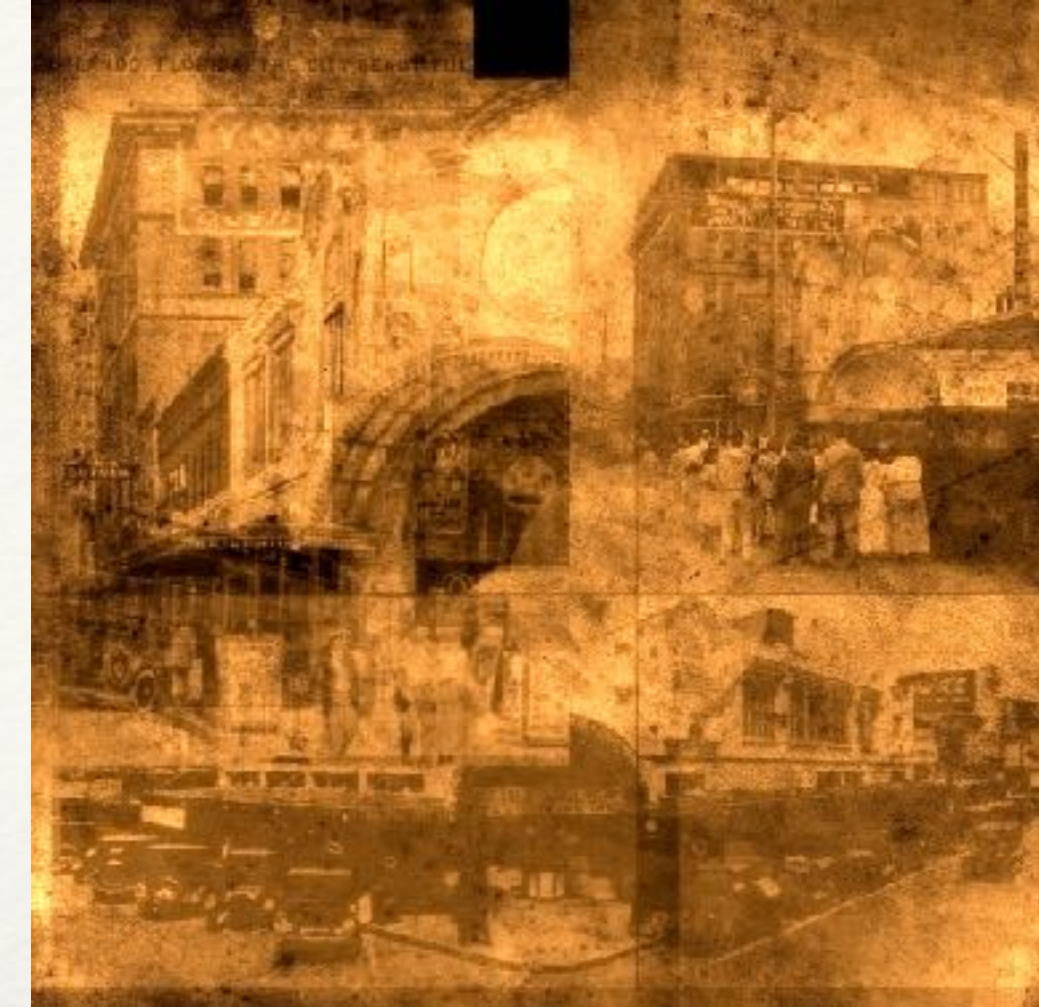

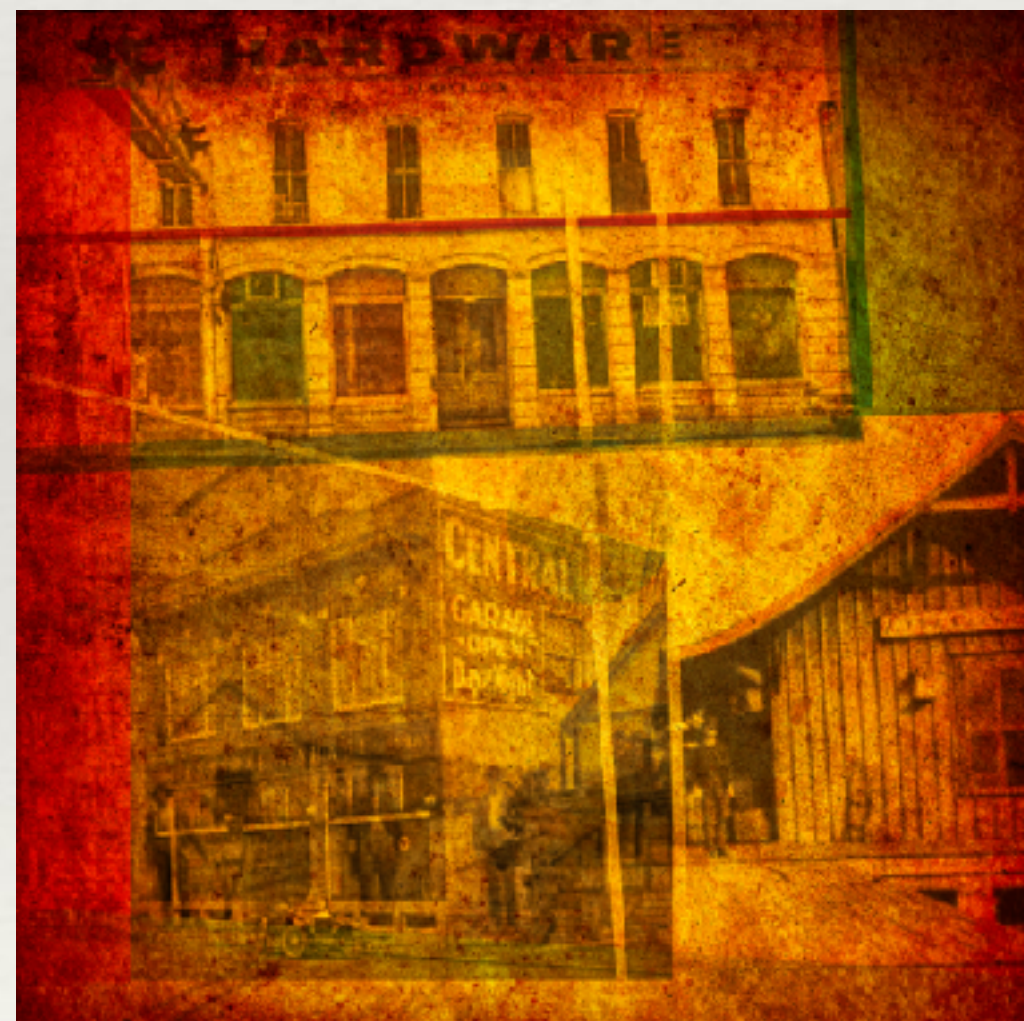
